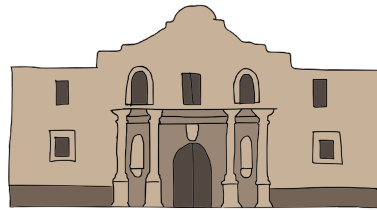

4. Store in a folder, envelope, sealing bag, or hole punch each card and place them on a ring.

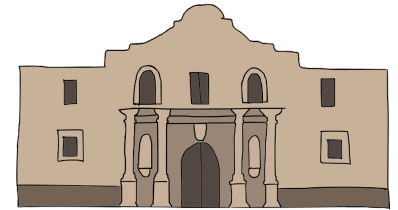
